Glaucoma remains one of the main cause of ocular morbidity worldwide, whose onset is promoted by a series of risk factors while its course includes different alteration pathways culminating with loss of sight. Although intraocular pressure is the main "druggable" target, it is been well established that intervene only on it is really not enough to prevent the retinal ganglion cell (RGC) loss. In this regard, neuroprotection is one of the most promising approaches for hampering the RGC degeneration.
