Different etiologies can cause HF, including congenital heart defects, coronary artery disease, and non-ischemic cardiomyopathies. Patients with HF have a reduced quality of life and suffer from chest pain, shortness of breath, fatigue and cardiac arrhythmias. Treatment of HF involves pharmacotherapy, interventional cardiology and cardiac surgery. Diagnosis and treatment of concomitant disorders play a key role in order to ensure appropriate follow-up care and post-transplant survival.
