The need for proper waste management was defined by the EU in the document Roadmap to a Resource Efficient Europe (EU COM 2011) and was additionally underlined in the last few years by the introduction of the concept of the circular economy by the European Commission (EC), initially in 2014, "Towards a circular economy: a zero-waste program for Europe" (EU COM 2014), and next in 2015, "Closing the loop: an EU action plan for the Circular Economy" (EU COM 2015). The term "waste valorisation" refers to any industrial processing activities that aim to reuse, recycle, or compost waste, thus converting it into valuable products or resources of energy. It usually takes the form of one of the following activities: the processing of residue or by-products into raw materials, the use of discarded finished or semi-finished products as raw materials or energy resources, the use of waste materials in manufacturing process stages, and the addition of waste materials to finished products.
