2018 TRAVEL AVVARDS

FOR POSTDOCS AND PHD STUDENTS

Candidates' Requirements:

- This award is open to postdoctoral fellows and PhD candidates involved in mathematics research. There is no age limit, but postdocs should have only completed their PhD within the last three years.
- 2. Will attend an international conference in 2018 (oral or poster presentations).
- 3. Applicants are required to submit the following documents:
 - Outline of current and future work, including an explanation of how the applicant will benefit from presenting their work at the conference (500 words).
 - Curriculum Vitae, including a complete list of publications.
 - The details of the planned conference (which conference, where, when, etc.)
 - The submitted abstract.
 - A letter of recommendation from the supervisor or PI, with a statement indicating the post-docs eligibility.

The award will consist of **800 CHF**/per person (Swiss Francs) for postdoctoral fellows and **500 CHF**/per person for PhD candidates toward the cost of attending the conference.
