The Award will sponsor residents, fellows, and other non-fellow postdoctoral trainees to attend an upcoming meeting *, while presenting an abstract as a first author. The stipend will be given on a competitive basis. This grant is restricted to a one-time acceptance.

The Award will consist of **800 Swiss Francs** (approximately **\$800 USD**) and is sponsored by the journal *Medicina*. Please apply online at <https://www.mdpi.com/journal/medicina/awards> by **30th April 2019**. The awardee will be announced by the end of **May 2019**.
