Dear Colleagues,

There is an international call to address racism and xenophobia in health. It overlaps in the Global North and Global South, as well as within low-income countries (LICs) and low-middle income countries (LMICs), and has been defined most recently in issues of decolonization regarding the dismantling of structural racism worldwide. The African diaspora is particularly prominent with continuing disparities in health, with patterns that impact other marginalized populations as having also been influenced by Eurocentric colonization. How study populations are defined, methodologies for assessing their "livedexperiences", imbalance in power within academic research and funding institutions, and the growth of "Anti-Racism Centers"—the latter having stemmed from 2020's so-called racial reckoning, present ongoing challenges within health and medical disciplines.
