### **Candidate Requirements:**

- PhD students or postdoctoral researchers in the membrane field.
- Will attend an international conference in 2019 (oral presentation or poster).

### **Required Application Documents:**

- The applicant's oral or poster abstract for the conference and the conference information (conference name, website, date and location)
- CV and a list of publications
- Justification letter describing the focus of their research (max. 500 words)
- Recommendation letter from the applicants' supervisors or PIs (principal investigators). The supervisors or PIs should sign and confirm that the applicant fulfills all requirements.
