The COVID-19 pandemic will continue to infect a large portion of the world's population and cause substantial morbidity and mortality until either an effective vaccine or a useful antiviral therapeutic is developed. To date, potential vaccines have a long lead time for development and their potential efficacy is uncertain given past failures with coronavirus vaccines. Furthermore, there is no approved antiviral therapy for COVID-19 infection. Therefore, alternative approaches must be explored in the hope of diminishing the potential consequences of COVID-19.
