We are pleased to announce that *Pathogens* is now inviting nominations for the *Pathogens* 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to two young investigators in recognition of their excellence in the field of pathogens and pathogen–host interactions. All nominations will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr Lawrence S. Young.

The prize:

- 1000 CHF (Swiss Francs);
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Pathogens* after peer review before the end of 2022;
- An engraved plaque.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have a PhD degree;
- Must be below 35 years of age by 31 December 2021;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of pathogens and pathogen–host interactions;
- Candidate must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Open for nominations: 01 October 2021;
- Nomination deadline: 30 April 2022;
- Winners announcement: 31 May 2022.
