We are pleased to announce the “*Photonics* 2021 Best Paper Award” for research and review articles published in *Photonics* from 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2021. One review and one research article will receive an award each. The papers will be selected after thorough evaluation by the journal Award Committee led by the EiC, Prof. Dr. Nelson Tansu, and the winners will be announced at the end of April 2023.

2021 BEST PAPER AWARD

Eligibility for the awards:

- Papers published in *Photonics* from 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2021;
- Open to all career levels;
- Both regular and Special Issue submissions will be considered.

Selection Criteria:

The papers will be selected by the journal Award Committee according to the following criteria (data source: Web of Science (Clarivate Analytics)):

- Scientific merit and broad impact;
- Relevance to the journal’s field;
- Originality of the research objectives and/or the ideas presented;
- Creativity of the study design or uniqueness of the approaches and concepts;
- Clarity of presentation;
- Citation and download rates in 2022.

Prizes:

- One review award: 500 CHF and a chance to publish a paper free of charge in *Photonics* before the end of April 2024;
- One research article award: 500 CHF and a chance to publish a paper free of charge in *Photonics* before the end of April 2024.
- Each winner will also receive a certificate.

The winners will be announced on the journal website at the end of April 2023.
