Dear Colleagues,

This special issue seeks contributions from diverse scholars who self-identify as evangelical and are doing research work into the contemporary practices of British evangelical Christians. The focus is on British evangelicalism due to its distinct history and theological dynamics, allowing for a coherent scope.

We are interested in accounts of what British evangelicals actually do in the day-to-day practicing of their faith; of how their practices form and sustain contemporary communities within the various contexts. Critical, reflexive, and constructive accounts that explore the theological implications of these practices are encouraged.

Contributions may draw on different conceptual understandings of practice and should range from 5000-10,000 words. Prior to submitting a manuscript, authors must provide a proposed title and an abstract of 200-300 words. Abstracts should be submitted to the Guest Editors by March 27, 2024. Full manuscripts will undergo double-blind peer review.
