Dear Colleagues,

The journal *Sensors* is inviting applications for the 2022 Best PhD Thesis Award. This prize will be awarded to one PhD student or doctor who has produced a highly anticipated academic potential thesis. The applications will be assessed by an evaluation committee led by Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Mehmet Rasit Yuce.

### **Eligibility requirements:**

- The candidate must be a PhD student or a doctor who has produced a highly anticipated academic potential thesis;
- The PhD thesis must be their original work;
- The PhD thesis must be defended between 1 September 2021 to 31 August 2022.

#### Applicants are also required to submit the following documents:

- An executive summary of the PhD thesis in English of around 3000 words;
- A letter from the PhD supervisor recommending the candidate for consideration for this award;
- The candidate's CV, including a list of publications connected with the thesis;
- An electronic copy of the PhD thesis;
- A scanned copy of the PhD diploma (or certificate of studying at a school or research institute as a PhD student going to graduate or participate in graduation thesis defenses).

## **Selection Criteria:**

- Quality of resume and publications;
- Relevance of the candidate and research description;
- Novelty of the candidate's PhD thesis;
- Strength of the recommendation letter;
- Anticipated academic potential;
- Originality and impact of the research.

#### **Prizes:**

- A bonus (CHF 1000);
- A certificate.

The application deadline is **31 August 2022**. The winner will be announced on the *Sensors* website by the end of October 2022.
