General requirements are that all candidates should be:

- PhD students or postdoctoral fellows with less than 5 years' experience post-PhD, and their research areas must be in systems science, systems engineering, or systems-related fields;
- They must present their own, original work as an oral presentation (or poster) at the conference for which the travel award application is being made.
