Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- The applicant's oral or poster abstract for the conference (list the conference name and its website).
- CV, including a complete list of publications.
- A justification letter (max. 500 words) describing the focus of their research, and what benefits the applicant could get from attending the conference.
- A letter of recommendation (max. 400 words) from a supervisor or PI (Principal Investigator). The supervisor or PI should sign and confirm that the applicant fulfills all requirements.
