# The Prize:

- CHF 2000 (Swiss Francs);
- An engraved plaque;
- The option to publish one paper free of charge in *Toxics* after peer review before the end of 2023.

# **Eligibility and Requirements:**

- Must have completed a PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2022;
- Must be below 40 years of age by 31 December 2022;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of the toxics field;
- Must be nominated by senior scientists.

## List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

# Schedule:

- Open for nominations: 19 May 2022;
- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2022;
- Winner announcement: 28 February 2023.
