The discovery of DDT and chloroquine ignited hope of conquering the disease, and the first global malaria eradication program initiated by World Health Organization was started in the mid 1950s. However, this ambitious program was soon terminated in 1967 due to the development of insecticide resistance in vectors and drug resistance in parasites.
