



We are pleased to announce that the "2019 *Water* Travel Award" is open now. We are inviting applications from postdoctoral and Ph.D. researchers who will attend an international conference in 2019. The award will consist of three prizes of **800 CHF (Swiss Francs)**.

The awardee will be determined by an evaluation committee, chaired by the Editor-in-Chief Prof. Arjen Y. Hoekstra, and also including Prof. Y. Jun Xu, Prof. Athanasios Loukas, Prof. Adriano A. Bordalo, Prof. Helena Margarida Ramos and Dr. Kevin B. Strychar.

2019 WATER TRAVEL A VA R D FOR POSTDOCTORAL AND PHD

Candidates should fulfil the following:

- Postdoctoral fellows (within three years of receiving their Ph.D.) or Ph.D. students undertaking water resources research field.
- They must present their own, original work as a poster or oral presentation at the conference for which the travel award application is being made.

Applicants are required to submit the following documents (PDF file):

- Outline of current and future work (1 page).
- CV, including a complete list of publications.
- The conference to be attended, a copy of the abstract and acceptance letter or anticipated date of decision.
- Current grant funding and travel budget, if any, and why the applicant wishes to have the support of *Water*.
- A letter of recommendation from their supervisor, research director or department head (1 page).

The equally-weighted selection criteria for the award consist of:

- Quality of the applicant;
- Quality of the conference research to be presented;
- The applicant's needs. Candidates from under-represented genders, cultural backgrounds and regions are encouraged to apply.
