We are interested in how LGBTIQ+ identity intersects with other aspects of identity (such as ethnicity, disability, and class), as well as strengths-based approaches to research and interventions with LGBTIQ+ youth.

Our focus for this Special Issue is on LGBTIQ+ youth, and we are keeping the scope of this Issue broad. We welcome submissions from a diverse range of disciplines and methodologies.
